1. Teaching

Action	Cost
Purchase whiteboards to facilitate AFL	£1k
Purchase Teaching Walkthrus and training materials	£1k
Integrate independent learning and distance learning contingency curriculum	£0
Purchase equipment packs, revision guides and curriculum software	£2k

2. Targeted academic support

Action	Cost
1-1 and small group tuition sessions	£3.24k
Literacy & Num support for SEN students (Catch-up reader enhanced, 1-1)	£2k
Purchase 20 devices for students required to Self-isolate without suitable access (laptop, tablet or desktop for minimum of 5hrs per day)	£5k

3. Wider strategies

Action	Cost
Part-time counsellor and online package to support SEMH	£10k
Online support sessions for parents of students with SEND	£400
Appoint Independent and Distance Learning support technician	£14k
