Welcome to our latest Headteacher letter. It has been pleasure observing our students in their lessons this half term; their focus and determination is impressive. # Entrance to school - Top gate

We recently contacted all parents/carers regarding the gate at the top of the school grounds as it had broken. This meant that all students have had to enter through our bottom pedestrian entrance for the last 2 weeks. Having this one gate arrival has enabled us to observe many benefits and the decision has been made to continue this arrangement for this school year. A one gate arrival has enabled more staff to welcome and support our students on their arrival; I have thoroughly enjoyed meeting and greeting every student as they have entered the school. The bottom gate entrance has also promoted a safer arrival for our students without the need to cross a busy road or access a narrow pavement that is shared with primary parents and their children. ## Attendance

Your child's attendance is of paramount importance to us at Parkside Community School. If attendance is poor it results in the following:

- A student who has 90% attendance misses 28 school days across the year. This equates to missing 168 lessons which is a huge amount of learning lost
- Poor examination results limit young people's options and poor attendance suggests to colleges and employers that these students are unreliable

Please do speak to your child about the importance of attending school on time every day; feeling tired or a little 'under weather' is not a reason to miss school. If we are able to provide further help with your child please get in touch. Thank you to all parents/carers for their support in this area.



#### Summer uniform – Half Term 6
