Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to let you know that I have been informed that members of the National Education Union (NEU), will be taking strike action, scheduled to take place on Wednesday 5 July and Friday 7 July.

School arrangements for Wednesday 5 July will be as follows:

Years 7, 8, and 9 will access remote learning at home.

Year 10 will access their normal Work Experience placements. For students who do not have a placement on that day and are due to attend school, they will access remote learning at home.

Pupils entitled to free school meals are invited to collect a meal between 11.30am and 12.30pm from the school canteen. Please reply via text – YES MEAL if you would like to request a free school meal for your child on Wednesday 5 July.

The second strike day - Friday 7 July is an INSET day so school will be closed to students.
