On Monday 15 November, Year 11 will begin their Mock Exams, which will run up to and include Thursday 25 November. The complete timetable is attached and we are working with students to prepare for the exams that are specific to them.

The Government have stated that exams will take place as normal next summer. The forthcoming mock exams therefore give us an invaluable opportunity to practice performing well under exam conditions, and to get feedback to inform next steps in learning. Mock exams provide the school with a very accurate picture of where individual students are at in their journey towards achieving their potential. This year will be all the more important given their absence from school during lockdown last year, the need to know where gaps in knowledge and skills exist, and how we can best use the time between now and the summer of 2022.

As we know, for the last two years schools have provided Teacher Assessed Grades, as exams have been cancelled. We are not expecting this to happen again. It is important, though, to be mindful of the fact that in both of those years, schools were required to draw upon all available evidence to decide on teacher assessed grades.

For the reasons given above, it is extremely important that students prepare well for their mock exams. Revision at home will help to consolidate learning in school. Students are strongly encouraged to undertake a range of practice and retrieval activities to support knowledge retention in each subject. All details of what to revise are available on SMHW. Please encourage your child to log-in to Satchel One (SMHW) on a daily basis to access any revision materials their class teacher may have uploaded. Last but not least, please encourage your child to limit their screen time, eat and drink healthily and get at least 8 hours of sleep per night during this very important time in Year 11.

The mock exams will take place in the Main Hall and are designed as much as possible to replicate the experience of sitting GCSE exams. This is a demanding time in any normal school year and we appreciate the impact the ongoing pandemic is having on students and families. Please do contact us if you have any concerns or would like some support. We know parents/carers will be concerned if a student has to self-isolate during the mock examinations. Please be assured that we have a contingency plan in place should this happen, and all students will receive support if this situation arises.

We are immensely proud of the commitment being shown by Year 11 since their return in September. They are a credit to themselves, to you and the wider school community. Now is the time to be positive, focussed, and to push on and use all the resources available to them to prepare effectively for their forthcoming exams, these next crucial months of learning, and success in the summer and beyond.
